	What Did Jesus Empty Himself of to Become a Man?			
	1) His	: He stepped down from the seat of ruling that is always His as God.		
	2) His	: He <i>surrendered</i> the riches that are always His as God.		
	3) His	: He <i>set aside</i> the rights that are always His as God.		
	4) His	: He sacrificed the relationship that is His with the Father on the Cross.
