The Man Who Had It All

The Circumstances Surrounding the Life of Samson:

1. The Philistines Were God's Agents of OPPRESSION!

Two Key Observations:

- Because of Israel's <u>SIN</u>, they were delivered into the Philistines' hands. Judges 13:1
- ➤ Because of God's <u>GRACE</u>, a deliverer was about to be born. *Judges 13:5*

2. Samson Was God's Agent of DELIVERANCE!

The Advantages of Samson's Life:

He was the man who HAD it all!

What advantages did Samson start out with?

> Samson started with God-ordained PURPOSE. Judges 13:5

The Nazirite Vow of Separation to the Lord (Numbers 6):

- 1) Must abstain from drinking wine or any strong drink.
- 2) Must avoid touching a dead body.
- 3) Must allow your hair to grow uncut.
- Samson started with God-fearing PARENTS. Judges 13:2-23
- Samson started with God-given POWER. Judges 13:24-25

The Tragedy of Samson's Life:

The man who had it all, LOST it all!

Life Lessons from a Flawed Hero:

- For Parents: Godly parents are <u>NO GUARANTEE</u> against children becoming ungodly adults.
- For Everyone: It's not how you <u>BEGIN</u>, but how you <u>END</u> that makes the difference.
