

A Man Who Made His Mark the Wrong Way: Demas = "Popular"

- Demas is mentioned only three times in the Bible, always by the Apostle Paul while he is in prison. Colossians 4:14; Philemon 24; 2 Timothy 4:10
- Demas is a powerful contrast to Luke with whom he is always compared to in the Bible.

Significant Comparisons between Luke & Demas	Sharp Contrast between Luke & Demas	
Both are only mentioned 3 times in the Bible

2 Timothy 4:10 takes place 3-4 years later after Colossians 4:14 and Philemon 24

- > Demas left the things of God to pursue the things of the world!
 - ♦ He left the *worker* of God 2 *Timothy 4:10*
 - ♦ He left the work of God Philemon 24
 - ♦ He left the will of God 1 John 2:17
 - ♦ He left the **way** of God 1 John 2:15; 5:4-5; James 4:4
