Lesson Two • Judges 14:1-20 **Pursuing What You Don't Need**

The Wrong Pursuit:

How did the man who had it all, lose it all? By pursuing what you don't NEED!

Another Key to Understanding Samson's Life:

Even when Samson's life is going "DOWNHILL" God's purpose is still being FULFILLED!

But his father and mother did not know that it was of the Lord—that He was seeking an occasion to move against the Philistines. For at that time the Philistines had dominion over Israel.

Judges 14:4

3. Samson WAGERS What He Tastes (Pride of Life)! Judges

14:11-14

Samson's Wager: "Bet you 30 new suits of clothes you can't SOLVE my riddle in seven days."

Samson's Riddle:

"Out of the eater came something to EAT, out of the strong came something SWEET."

4. Samson LOSES What He Wagers (Price of Sin)! Judges 14:15-20

Samson lost much more than his wager, he lost... His parent's RESPECT, His Nazirite SEPARATION, His WIFE to his best man, His INTEGRITY to lead Israel.

Pursuing What You Don't Need:

1. Samson WANTS What He Sees (Lust of the Eyes)! Judges 14:1-4

One of Samson's Fatal Mistakes:

He rejected the COUNSEL of his parents.

Life Lessons from a Flawed Hero:

When we pursue what we don't NEED, we receive what we don't WANT.

2. Samson TASTES What He Wants (Lust of the Flesh)! Judges 14:5-10

Sin's Design for Our Lives:

To distract and steer us off the RIGHT PATH by enticing us to pursue our own lusts.

There is a difference between being EMPOWERED by the Spirit and CONTROLLED by the Spirit.
