## Perseverance in MISSIONAL LIVING

Lesson 3 – Psalm of Ascents 129

God has called every Christ-Follower and every local church to...

God's MISSION ... the big picture of God's plan.

Do MISSIONS ... the global part of God's plan.

Be MISSIONAL ... the daily practice of God's plan.

Last week – The **Power for Missional Living** comes from God not us ... by faith, bearing fruit, with eternal fulfillment.

## Today – Perseverance in Missional Living.

Definition – **Perseverance:** Steady persistence in a course of action or a purpose ... *especially* in spite of difficulties, obstacles, or discouragement.

## Psalm 129

Verse 1-2 - "they have not prevailed against me."

Verse 3-4 – "The Lord is righteous" – He did not forget them! He loosed the bonds and freed them!

Verse 5 – Put them to shame and full retreat (reversal of fortune)!

Verse 6-7 – Let them be worthless and wasted!

Verse 8 – May they be rejected and no one show them the courtesy of inclusion in the blessing.

Verses 5-8 can be viewed as *statements of confidence* rather than wishes. Psalm 97:7, 6:10
