SAMSON: Man of Strength, Man of Weakness

Lesson Four • Judges 16:1-22 Samson's Bad Hair Day

Toying with Temptation:

Samson chose to toy with <u>TEMPTATION</u>, and his life became an illustration of two of the Bible's great warnings:

Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall. Proverbs 16:18 Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall. 1Corinthians 10:12

The Hardest Thing You Will Ever Say:

"I have a PROBLEM!"

The Philistine's Proposal:

The five lords of the Philistines offered Delilah a huge bounty if she discovered the <u>SECRET</u> of Samson's strength. vs. 5

Delilah's Beauty Salon & Samson's Bad Hair Day:

Delilah "nagged Samson to death" with her <u>WORDS</u> so that he "told her all his heart." vs. 16-17

3. Sin Will COST You More Than You Wanted To Pay!

Judges 16:18-23 (Samson and Self-Destruction)

The Saddest Statements about Samson:

"And his strength <u>LEFT</u> him." vs. 19 "But he did not <u>KNOW</u> that the Lord had departed from him." vs. 20

The High Cost of Samson's Sin:

"Then the Philistines took him and put out his eyes (mutilation), and brought him down to Gaza (deportation). They bound him with bronze fetters (incarceration), and he became a grinder in the prison (humiliation)." vs. 21

The Healing Grace of God: "However, the hair of his head began to GROW again after it had been shaven."

When You Toy with Temptation ...

1. Sin Will TAKE You Farther Than You Wanted To Go!

Judges 16:1-3 (Samson and the Prostitute)

Samson and the Prostitute:

- Samson sees and visits a <u>PROSTITUTE</u> in Gaza. vs. 1
- > The Philistines plot to <u>KILL</u> Samson in the morning. vs. 2
- Samson ESCAPES by picking up the city gates and carrying them off. vs. 3

2. Sin Will <u>KEEP</u> You Longer Than You Wanted To Stay! Judges 16:4-17 (Samson and Delilah)

vs. 22

Life Lessons from a Flawed Hero:

- Unless we deal with our <u>PROBLEMS</u> they will come back to haunt us again and again.
- We can <u>FALL</u> like Samson if do not learn that we cannot toy with temptation.
- Even in our failure we can still experience God's healing <u>GRACE</u>.
