Proverbs 5:15-23; Genesis 26:8 For SINGLES – Never kiss outside of marriage in a way that defrauds the other person by promising more than you can deliver in the sight of God or arousing passions in the other person that you cannot satisfy before a holy God! 1Thessalonians 4:1-10	 Some kiss <i>deceptively</i> to selfishly get what they want from others. <i>Genesis</i> 27:26-27 Some kiss <i>hypocritically</i> to use others for their own selfish purposes. <i>2Samuel</i> 15:5 Some kiss <i>treacherously</i> using friendship as a cover to get close enough to hurt their enemies and get their revenge. <i>2Samuel</i> 20:9 Some kiss <i>seductively</i> to satisfy their own lust with no regard for God's holiness. <i>Proverbs</i> 7:12-15 Some kiss <i>idolatrously</i> in their worship of manmade idols and false gods. <i>1 Kings</i> 19:18; Job 31:26-27; Hosea 13:2

>	The Judas Kiss was a distortion of the Kiss of! While He was still speaking, behold, a crowd came, and the one called Judas, one of the twelve, was preceding them; and he approached Jesus to kiss Him. 48 But Jesus said to him, "Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?" Luke 22:47-48
	So What 's in the Kiss of Affection According to the Bible? KINSHIP: A cultural way of showing affection to one another as in the family of God.
	"Do not sharply rebuke an older man, but rather appeal to him as a father, to the younger men as brothers, the older women as mothers, and
>	FELLOWSHIP: A cultural way of greeting one another to express for one another in Christ.
	"Greet one another with a kiss of love. Peace be to you all who are in Christ." 1Peter 5:14
>	WORSHIP: A cultural way of <i>worshipping our Triune God</i> as we with one another as a congregation or small group.
	"Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the saints greet you. "Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the saints greet you. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, be with you all." 2 Corinthians 13:12-14
