

Following in the Footsteps of Jesus Justus

Lesson 6 • Colossians 4:11

Colossians 4:7-18 reminds us that our ministry to others is the overflow of our relationship with Christ. 12 people are mentioned by name. Each one sought to make their mark for eternity. We are following in the footsteps of those who fulfilled their ministries, so we too can make our mark for eternity!

A Man Who Made His Mark: Jesus Justus = "The LORD is Salvation" and "Righteous"

Jesus Justus is mentioned **only once** in the Bible, though there are three different men named Justus in the NT.

- 1) Joseph Barsabbas (Son of Rest) Justus (Acts 1:23)
- 2) Titus Justus (Acts 18:7)
- 3) Jesus Justus (Colossians 4:11)

Like so many Jewish people at this time, Justus had a Jewish name and a Roman (Latin) name.
