### Motivation #1 Work to SHOW YOUR LOVE FOR GOD.

"Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" And [Jesus] said to him, "'YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.' "This is the great and foremost commandment." Matthew 22:35-38

Whether, then, you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. 1Corinthians 10:31

Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, Colossians 3:23

#### Motivation #4 Work to MAKE A PROFIT FOR A PURPOSE.

We work to make a profit for a purpose and that purpose is to provide for ourselves and especially others!

- ▶ Provide for your **OWN FAMILY**. Ephesians 4:28a; 1Thessalonians 4:9-11; 2 Thessalonians 3:6-15; 1 Timothy 5:5-8
- ➤ Provide for **GOD'S FAMILY**, especially those who work hard at feeding you.

The Biblical Principle: Don't muzzle the ox while it is threshing! 1Timothy 5:17-18; 1 Corinthians 9:9-14; 2 Timothy 2:6

- 1) Those who work hard have the **RIGHT** to be paid and enjoy it!
- 2) Those who benefit from the hard work of others have the **<u>RESPONSIBILITY</u>** to pay them and let them enjoy it!
- ➤ Provide for OTHERS who cannot provide for themselves. 2 Thessalonians 3:10; Ephesians 4:28b
