	What Does that Mean?		
	1) Serving ("for ministry to the saints") and Helping ("everyone who helps")		
	2) Working ("in the work") and Laboring ("and labors")		
	2) Surrendering ("devoted") and Volunteering ("themselves")		
	They voluntarily knelt down and said to the Lord: "I will work hard at serving Your people and helping others to do the same!"
