### The PROBLEM: We Are All Like Lost Sheep Without a Shepherd.

- 1. Jesus uses shepherding as a powerful **word picture** to drive home a spiritual point. (v. 6)
  - Shepherding was a common cultural word picture.
  - Shepherding was a familiar biblical word picture.
  - Shepherding was a very *practical* word picture.
- 2. Jesus uses shepherding to show us that we have a profound *spiritual problem*.

The Problem of Lost Sheep  Matthew 9:36; Mark 6:34	The Provision of the Good Shepherd Numbers 27:16; 1Kings 22:17; John 10
We Are Harassed Wanderers  Bothered and Bewildered, Beaten and Bruised	We Need the Staff of Sacrificial Leadership  Compassion that Does Not Use the Sheep
We Are Helpless Wanderers  Cast Down = Fallen and Can't Get Up!	We Need the Rod of Strong Leadership  Correction that Does Not Abuse the Sheep

# Eight Characteristics of the Good Shepherd 1. The Good Shepherd \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ through the Door of the sheepfold. (vv. 2-3; 4:34; 5:30; 6:38-40) 2. The Good Shepherd \_\_\_\_\_\_ His own sheep. (v. 3)

- Response of those who are **not** His Sheep: 7:40-53; 8:13, 19, 22, 25, 27, 33, 48, 52-53, 57, 59; 9:16, 24-34, 40; 10:6, 19-21, 24, 31, 33, 39
- Response of those who are His Sheep: 8:30; 9:35-38

3.	The Good Shepherd	His own sheep by name. (vv. 3, 14-15, 27)
4.	The Good Shepherd	His sheep out of the fold into good pasture. (vv. 3, 9; Psalm 23:1-4)
5.	The Good Shepherd	before His sheep as an example. (vv. 4; 13:15)
6.	The Good Shepherd	_ His sheep from eternal harassment and spiritual helplessness.
7.	The Good Shepherd	for His sheep. (vv. 11-15, 17-18)
8.	The Good Shepherd	_ to reign for His glory and the good of His sheep. (vv. 17-18; of iron" passages in Revelation: 2:27; 12:5; 19:15)
