The Gospel of John can be divided into two main parts: SIGNS and GLORY!

WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE SEVEN SIGNS IN JOHN 1-12?

1. JOHN IS STICKING TO HIS PURPOSE FOR WRITING: "BELIEVE IN MIRACLES BUT TRUST IN JESUS!" (1:11-14; 20:30-31)

THREE TYPES OF PEOPLE WHO SEE THE SIGNS

- FAITHFUL FOLLOWERS with saving faith in the Sovereign Savior.
- FICKLE FANS with only sign faith in the sensational and the sensual.
- FIERCE FOES with no faith in either the signs or the Sovereign Savior.

FAITH RESPONSES BY PEOPLE WHO SEE THE SIGNS

- Sign #1 The disappointed Disciples who have no more joy in life believe with saving faith. (2:11)
- Sign #2 The desperate Royal Official who sees no more possibility of life goes from sign faith to saving faith. (4:50-54)
- Sign #3 The disabled Man who had no more ability in life appears to only have the sign faith or no faith at all, because it is never recorded that he believed at all and after being warned by Jesus of God's wrath on his sin reports Jesus to the Jewish leaders with no faith and are determined to kill Him. (5:8-16)
- Sign #4 The dissatisfied Crowds who have no more provision for life are fickle fans who are persistent in their pursuit of sign faith and the Jewish leaders with no faith are fierce foes who are determined to kill him. Even so-called "disciples" choose to stop following when the handouts and healings come to an end. (6:35-40)
 - Jesus knows who are His **faithful followers** with **saving faith** and who are merely **fickle fans** with mere **sign faith**. He even knows Judas has **no faith** and will betray Him as a **fierce foe!** (6:60-70)
- Sign #5 The distressed Disciples who have no more stability in life are strengthened in their saving faith to be faithful followers even when the handouts end and the storm still rages. (6:20-21)

- Sign #6 The darkness of the blind man, who has no more insight into life, sees the light with a saving faith that is willing to risk it all to worship and faithfully follow Jesus at all costs. All the while those with no faith remains in their sin of unbelief and fierce opposition to Jesus. (9:35-41; 10:19-21, 39-42)
- Sign #7 The death of Lazarus, who has no more life at all, is restored to life and the saving faith of him and his sisters is strengthened to faithfully follows Jesus who Himself is about to be crucified and resurrected as the Lord over Life and Death! The response to the seventh sign is filled with saving faith of faithful followers, sign faith of fickle fans, and no faith by the fiercest of foes! (11:45-48, 53-57; 12:9-11)

In each case the *minor thing* is the <u>MIRACLE</u> and the *main thing* is <u>JESUS</u>—*His glory for our good and the good of others!*See the glory of the Sovereign Savior and savor Him in all of life's circumstances!

Z. JOHN IS SHARING LIFE-GIVING LESSONS ON SAVING FAITH.

EIGHT LIFE-GIVING LESSONS ON SAVING FAITH

- #1 Sign faith FALLS SHORT of saving faith, but it can GROW into saving faith.
- #2 Saving faith is a SOVEREIGN gift of God's grace, but it still requires COMING to Jesus by faith.
- #3 Saving faith should grow into STRONGER faith.
- #4 Saving faith PERSEVERES through times of testing, but sign faith falls away.
- #5 Saving faith will eventually be <u>PERSECUTED</u>—often fiercely—by those with sign faith or no faith.
- #6 Saving faith can be FAKED by those with sign faith or no faith and even FOOL those with saving faith.
- #7 Saving faith OBEYS by receiving Jesus Christ as the Son of God and RESTS in Him as the seal of God's salvation.
- **#8** Saving faith is both a **POINT** in time and an ongoing **PROCESS**.

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who *is believing* (present tense) in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who *is living* (present tense) and *is believing* (present tense) in Me will never die. *Are you believing* (present tense) this?" She said to Him, "Yes, Lord; *I have believed and still do believe* (perfect tense) that You are the Christ, the Son of God, *even* He who comes into the world." (11:25-27)

If you short change the process, you may settle for sign faith rather than saving faith!

If you never decisively arrive at the point or never urgently appeal others to do so, you or they may never receive the security and satisfaction of saving faith!

3. JOHN IS **SHOWING** US THE GLORY OF JESUS AS THE SON OF GOD, SO WE WILL TRUST HIM AND TREASURE HIM AS OUR SOVEREIGN SAVIOR AT ALL TIMES!

Believe in miracles but trust in Jesus and treasure Him at all times even when the miracles are delayed or don't come at all!

WE NEED THE SON OF GOD IN ALL HIS GLORY SO MUCH MORE THAN JUST HIS SIGNS!

➤ Trust Jesus for **WHO** He is and **WHAT** He has done, is doing, and has yet to do for His glory and the good of others through His gospel!

INSTEAD OF BEING A FICKLE FAN WITH SIGN FAITH, BE A FAITHFUL FOLLOWER WITH SAVING FAITH!

➤ Treasure Jesus even when the miracles are delayed or do not come at all until the He comes again!
