The promise of Christ's coming should motivate and move us to PERSEVERE in our faith!

Therefore, beloved... 2Peter 3:14

A Faith That Perseveres:

I. Keep **LOOKING** with Hope to Christ's Coming!

Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things... 2Peter 3:14

2. Be <u>DILIGENT</u> to Pursue Peace and Purity!

Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless; 2Peter 3:14

3. Regard the Lord's <u>PATIENCE</u> as a Time of Salvation!

And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation... 2Peter 3:15

Interpreting the Time in Which We Live:

4. Remain STEADFAST in the Truth of God's Word!

- Remain steadfast in <u>APPLYING/USING</u> God's Word: It's easy to twist Scripture to justify our sins, but it can lead to our destruction.
