# JESUS: Behold His Glory

Lesson Four • John 1:19-34 Behold the Glory of The Lamb

#### **Behold His Glory:**

Jesus is the LAMB of God who takes away the sin of the world!

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" John 1:29 NKJV

Again, the next day, John stood with two of his disciples. And looking at Jesus as He walked, he said, "Behold the Lamb of God!" John 1:35-36 NKJV

#### > Jesus would die for the sins of the WORLD.

He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world. 1John 2:2 NIV

"Worthy are You to take the scroll and to open its seals, for You were slain, and by Your blood You ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation." Revelation 5:9 ESV

#### Only One Way to Have Your Sins Taken Away and Find Peace with God:

You must <u>BELIEVE</u> in Jesus as your Lamb who takes away your sin and reconciles you to God!

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 ESV

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him. John 3:36 ESV

But as many as received Him [Jesus], to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name. John 1:12 NKJV

#### Behold the Glory of The Lamb:

### 1. Only Jesus Is the Lamb <u>WITHOUT SIN</u>!

You know that He appeared in order to take away sins, and in Him there is no sin. 1John 3:5 ESV

For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. 1Peter 1:18-19 NIV

He committed no sin, and no deceit was found in His mouth. 1Peter 2:22 NIV

## 2. Only Jesus Is the Lamb Who TAKES AWAY SIN!

#### What does this mean?

> Jesus would <u>DIE</u> like a sacrificial lamb.

We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. He was oppressed and afflicted, yet He did not open His mouth; He was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so He did not open His mouth. Isaiah 53:6-7 NIV

#### A Prayer to Receive Jesus as Your Lamb and Lord:

May these words be the vehicle God uses to create faith in your heart and receive Jesus...

"Dear Jesus, for too long I've kept you out of my life. But today I want to open my heart to You and receive You as my Savior and Lord. Thank You for coming to save me from my sins. With all my heart I believe You are the Son of God who died on the Cross as the Lamb for my sins and rose again. Thank You for creating in me new life and giving me the gift of eternal life. Amen."
