Behold His Glory:

The baby in the manger is Jesus the LORD!

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His alory, the alory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14 "For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." Luke 2:11
