Do You Need a Fresh Start in Your Finances?

If demand exceeds supply and your cry is "NOT ENOUGH" at the end of the week or month, then take notice of the economic plan of Jesus!

The Economic Plan of Jesus for His People:

I. <u>WITHOUT</u> Christ Demand Exceeds Supply and the Cry Is "Not Enough!" John 6:1-9

The Need of the Multitude:

To minister to the needs of over 5,000 people by <u>FEEDING</u> them.

The Need of the Our Church:

To minister to the needs of people by <u>FUNDING</u> our mission of leading people to become fully devoted followers of Jesus.

Three Things Can Cause the Problem of Demand Exceeding Supply:

- ➤ If we have no sense of PLANNING in our lives. vs. 1-5
- ➤ If we have no sense of PURPOSE in our stewardship. vs. 5-9
- > If we have no sense of POTENTIAL through Christ. vs. 9

2. <u>WITH</u> Christ Supply Exceeds Demand and the Cry Is "More Than Enough!" John 6:10-14

How did supply exceed demand of feeding the multitude?

It began when a little boy was willing to give his **LUNCH** to Jesus.

How will supply exceed demand of funding our church's mission?

It begins when I am willing to give my FINANCES to God.

Two Powerful Economic Principles of God:

- God delights in using our <u>GIVING</u> to accomplish His purposes no matter how much or how little.
- God delights in making up the <u>DIFFERENCE</u> in our apparent problems of demand exceeding supply.

Key Question: Are You Willing to TRUST God with Your Finances?

Just as the little boy put his lunch in the hands of Jesus, are you willing to put your finances in the hands of God?

Three Steps to Take in God's Economic Plan:

Ц	GIVE a portion of your income to God first.
	\underline{ASK} God to use your giving to make up the difference.
