Getting the Gospel Everywhere

1. May We Be a Church Centered on the GOSPEL of Jesus Christ!

Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. Acts 13:1

The Power of the Gospel

- The Antioch Church was ESTABLISHED by the Gospel. Acts 11:19-30

- The Antioch Church was UNITED by the Gospel.

2. May We Be a Church Captivated in the WORSHIP of God!

As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said... Acts 13:2

3. May We Be a Church Controlled by the SPIRIT of God!

The Holy Spirit said, “Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.” Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away. Acts 13:2-3

The Synergy Between the Spirit and the Church

- The Spirit leads, and the church FOLLOWS.

- The Spirit calls, and the church CONFIRMS.

- The Spirit sends, and the church SUPPORTS.

“Laid Hands on Them”

An act of recognizing the Spirit’s call, identifying with those being called, and commending them to the grace of God for the mission.

From there they sailed to Antioch, where they had been commended to the grace of God for the work which they had completed. Acts 14:26
