Finding Hope In A Disappointing World

Lesson Four • Ruth 1:14-18 Grace at the Bottom of the Barrel

The Principle: Our response to disappointment in life will determine our <u>WALK WITH GOD</u>.

Ruth Found Grace at the Bottom of the Barrel:

- Ruth found a new <u>DIRECTION</u> in life.
- Ruth found a new <u>PLACE</u> to belong.
- Ruth found a new <u>PEOPLE</u> to love.
- Ruth found a new <u>GOD</u> to worship.
- > Ruth found a new <u>PEACE</u> in her heart.

Our Response to Disappointment in Life:

1. Like Orpah, We Can Respond With <u>DESERTION</u>! Ruth 1:14-

Shedding Orpah Tears:

Orpah shows us that it's possible to $\underline{\text{HEAR}}$ of God's grace and yet turn our backs on God.

Ruth Is Proof...

That God is neither dead nor distant, but is at <u>WORK</u> in the worst of times to accomplish His good purposes.

2. Like Ruth, We Can Respond With <u>DETERMINATION</u>! Ruth 1:16-18

Ruth's Act of Commitment:

"Orpah kissed her mother-in-law, but Ruth CLUNG to her."

Ruth's Pledge of Commitment:

Ruth pledged to <u>ABANDON</u> all her prior allegiances and to <u>ADOPT</u> Naomi's family and faith as her own in life, for life, and beyond life.

"Entreat me not leave you, or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; and wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, and your God, my God. Where you die, I will die, and there will I be buried. The Lord do so to me, and more also, if anything but death parts you and me." Ruth 1:16-17 Finding Grace at the Bottom of the Barrel:

Respond to your disappoints in life with <u>FAITH IN GOD</u> that sees beyond present bitter setbacks.
