## It Pays to Give

## What Is the Generosity Paradox?

By GIVING we receive; by GRASPING we lose.

But as you abound in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us—see that you abound in this grace also. 2Corinthians 8:7 NKJV And in this matter I give my judgment: this benefits you... 2Corinthians 8:10a ESV

## It Pays to Give

# 1. The Principle: We Reap in MEASURE as We Sow!

But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. 2Corinthians 9:6 NKJV

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. Galatians 6:7-8 NIV

# 2. The Practice: We Reap as We Sow with the Right <u>HEART!</u>

So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. 2Corinthians 9:7 NKJV

#### The Practice of Generosity

- Give INTENTIONALLY.
- Give WILLINGLY.
- Give JOYFULLY.

# 3. The Promise: We Reap Even WHILE We Are Sowing!

Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.

### Three Words That Can Transform Your Life!

"GOD IS ABLE"
