Jesus Came to Make You See

I'd Love to Be Able to See...

Lessons from a Close Encounter Between a Blind Man and Jesus:

1. Break Through EITHER/OR Thinking!

- The disciples ask for the CAUSE of the man's blindness.

"Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" John 9:2

The Result of Either/Or Thinking:

You feel TRAPPED.

- Jesus answers with a PURPOSE for the man's blindness.

"Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him." John 9:3

Why Break Through Either/Or Thinking?

You never know when or how God will break into your life with transforming POWER.

2. Dare To TRUST God!

When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay. And He said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" (which is translated, Sent). So he went and washed, and came back seeing. John. 9:6-7

3. Look Past What Others Cannot SEE!

- The neighbors were blinded by SKEPTICISM. *John 9:8-10*
- The Pharisees were blinded by UNBELIEF. *John 9:13-18*
- The parents were blinded by FEAR. *John 9:18-23*

The Blind Man's Testimony:

*"One thing I know: I was BLIND, but now I SEE."
John 9:24-25*

4. Believe In Jesus To SAVE You!

What did Jesus come do to for you?

Jesus came as the "light of the world" to give you spiritual sight so you may BELIEVE in Him as Savior & Lord for eternal life.

"I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness." John 12:46

Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said to him, "Do you believe in the Son of God?" He answered and said, "Who is He, Lord, that I may believe in Him?" And Jesus said to him, You have both seen Him and it is He who is talking with you." Then he said, "Lord, I believe!" And he worshiped Him. John 9:35-38

Do You "See" Jesus? Then Respond to Him!

He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him. John 3:36
