Overcoming Financial Stress

God's Promise:

You don't have to <u>WORRY</u> about financial problems because God will meet all your needs!

"And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:19 NIV

The Conditions: God Promises to Meet My Financial Needs...

1. If I Ask God <u>FOR HIS HELP</u>!

"And I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you." ~Jesus, Luke 11:9 NKJV

You do not have, because you do not ask God. James 4:2 NIV

"Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full." ~Jesus, John 16:24 ESV

2. If I Learn <u>TO BE CONTENT</u>!

"For I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want." Philippians 4:11-12 NIV

But godliness with contentment is great gain, for we brought nothing into the world, and we cannot take anything out of the world. But if we have food and clothing, with these we will be content. 1Timothy 6:6-8 ESV

Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for He has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." Hebrews 13:5 ESV

3. If I Practice **GIVING IN FAITH**!

Honor the LORD with your possessions, and with the firstfruits of all your increase; so your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine. Proverbs 3:9-10 NKJV Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. 2Corinthians 9:6-8 NIV

4. If I Maintain MY INTEGRITY!
