Solomon's Message in Psalm 127: Without the Lord, <u>FRUSTRATION</u>. With the Lord, <u>SATISFACTION</u>.

Frustration or Satisfaction?

1. Without the Lord, Our WORK Is Pointless!

Unless the LORD builds the house, they labor in vain who build it; unless the LORD guards the city, the watchman stays awake in vain. Psalm 127:1

The Tower of Babel:

Is a disastrous example of the <u>FUTILITY</u> of self-reliance and the <u>FOLLY</u> of self-sufficiency. *Genesis 11:1-9*

Two Encouraging Truths:

- ➤ God loves to WORK. Genesis 1
- ➤ God makes our work MEANINGFUL. Colossians 3:23-24

2. Without the Lord, Our <u>LIVES</u> Are Restless!

It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows; for so He gives His beloved sleep. Psalm 127:2

Two More Encouraging Truths:

- > God gives SLEEP to those who trust in Him.
- God WORKS for those who trust in Him while they sleep.

3. Without the Lord, Our HOMES Are Fruitless!

Behold, children are a heritage from the LORD, the fruit of the womb is a reward.

Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, so are the children of one's youth.

Happy is the man who has his quiver full of them; they shall not be ashamed, but shall speak with their enemies in the gate. Psalm 127:3-5

The Illustration of Children:

Children are a GIFT from the Lord, not the result of our work.

The Good News from Solomon's Life:

When we <u>TRUST</u> the Lord in all matters of life we will enjoy satisfaction instead of enduring frustration.
