Lesson Three • Psalm 3 When Life Falls Apart

The Context of Psalm 3: David wrote this psalm when he <u>FLED</u> for his life from his son Absalom. 2Samuel 15-18

When Life Falls Apart:

There is always HOPE when God is on your side.

What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? Romans 8:31

Why? Because of Who the Lord Is:

- > The Lord is our <u>PROTECTING</u> God.
- > The Lord is our <u>SUFFICIENT</u> God.
- > The Lord is our <u>RESTORING</u> God.

Why? Because of What the Lord Has Done:

- > The Lord <u>HEARS</u> our cries.
- > The Lord <u>SUSTAINS</u> our lives.
- > The Lord <u>CALMS</u> our fears.

3. Anticipate Your <u>DELIVERANCE</u> from the Lord!

Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God! For You have struck all my enemies on the cheekbone; You have broken the teeth of the ungodly. Salvation belongs to the LORD. Your blessing is upon Your people. Psalm 3:7-8

When Enemies Rise Up Against You:

Will you seek <u>REVENGE</u> or leave vengeance in God's hands?

Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord." Romans 12:19 ESV

"Salvation Belongs to the Lord!"

PRAY for deliverance and then PRAISE God for His deliverance.

If God is for us, who can be against us? Who shall separated us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. Romans 8:31, 35, 37

When Life Falls Apart:

1. Admit Your <u>TROUBLES</u> to the Lord!

LORD, how they have increased who trouble me! Many are they who rise up against me. Many are they who say of me, "There is no help for him in God." Psalm 3:1-2

The Troubles David Told the Lord:

- > David told the Lord what his enemies were <u>DOING</u>.
- > David told the Lord what his enemies were <u>SAYING</u>.

2. Affirm Your <u>CONFIDENCE</u> in the Lord!
