Grace for Getting Back in the Race

We are bent on backsliding from God, but God is always ready to $\underline{\text{FORGIVE}}$ us when we return to Him.

"I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely, for My anger has turned away from Me." Hosea 14:4 NKJV

It's Your Move

Will you <u>RETURN</u> to the Lord your God?

0 Israel, return to the LORD your God, for you have stumbled because of your iniquity. Hosea 14:1 NKJV

So you, by the help of your God, return. Hosea 12:6 NKJV

2. How Do We Repent of Sin? By <u>FOLLOWING</u> God's Steps!

O Israel, return to the LORD your God, for you have stumbled because of your iniquity; take words with you, and return to the Lord. Say to Him, "Take away all iniquity; receive us graciously, for we will offer the sacrifices of our lips. Assyria shall not save us, we will not on horses, nor will we say anymore to the work of our hands, 'You are our gods.' For in You the fatherless finds mercy." Hosea 14:1-3 NKJV

God's Steps of Repentance:

- Recognize your <u>SIN</u> against God.
- ➢ Receive <u>FORGIVENESS</u> by God's grace.
- > Renounce your <u>RELIANCE</u> on false gods.
- > Reaffirm your <u>FAITH</u> in God alone.

Runners Returning, God Forgiving

1. How Do We Return to God? By <u>REPENTING</u> of Our Sin!

0 Israel, return to the LORD your God, for you have stumbled because of your iniquity; take words with you, and return to the Lord. Hosea 14:1-2a NKJV

Beware of Phony Repentance!

Our repentance of sin must be <u>AUTHENTIC</u> because phony repentance will produce phony results.

Come, let us return to the Lord. He has torn us to pieces but He will heal us; He has injured us but He will bind up our wounds. After two days He will revive us; on the third day He will restore us, that we may live in His presence. Let us acknowledge the Lord; let us press on to acknowledge Him. As surely as the sun rises, He will appear; He will come to us like the winter rains, like the spring rains that water the earth. Hosea 6:1-3 NIV

"What can I do with you, Ephraim? What can I do with you, Judah? Your love is like the morning mist, like the early dew that disappears." Hosea 6:4 NIV

Our Response to God's Grace & Mercy

Don't <u>DELAY</u>, but today return to the Lord in repentance of sin.
