Simple Savior

The Babe in the Manger...

Turned out to be the SAVIOR of the world!

"For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. And this will be a sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger."

Luke 2:11-12

Who is Jesus the "Simple Savior" and what difference does He make in my life today?

Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. Revelation 1:4

Three Questions for Jesus the Simple Savior:

Question 1: Can I TRUST Jesus?

I urge you in the sight of God who gives life to all things, and before Christ Jesus who witnessed the good confession before Pontius Pilate, 1Timothy 6:13

Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice." John 18:37

Can I trust Jesus?

Yes I can, for He is the FAITHFUL witness.

Question 2: Does Jesus Have the POWER to Help Me?

For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. 1Thessalonians 4:14

Does Jesus have the power to help me?

Yes He does, for He is the FIRSTBORN from the dead.

Question 3: Will Jesus TAKE CARE of My Future?

These will make war with the Lamb [Jesus], and the Lamb will overcome them, for He is the Lord of lords and King of kings... Revelation 17:14

And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written:

KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Revelation 19:16

Will Jesus take care of my future?

Yes He will, for He is the RULER of the kings of the earth.

How Should I Respond to the Simple Savior?

HOLD FAST to Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth!
