When faced with a problem in life, how do you respond?

Most people respond: "I can TACKLE it on my own!"

Three Lessons for Tackling Our Problems in Life:

1. When We Try to Tackle Problems On Our Own, We Make a MESS in Our Lives! Gen. 12:10-13

When We Tackle Problems On Our Own:

➤ We fail to TRUST God. vs. 1-10

Will I trust God, whatever the circumstances?

We fail to OBEY God. vs. 10

Will I obey God, whatever the cost?

➤ We fail to FEAR God. vs. 11-13

Will I fear God, whatever the opposition?

	>	Some consequences are <u>IMMEDIATE</u> while others are <u>DELAYED</u> . <i>Gen. 13:5-7</i>
	>	Few consequences affect only <u>ONE</u> person while most affect <u>MANY</u> people. <i>Gen. 16:1-6</i>
	>	All consequences serve as $\underline{REMINDERS}$ of what happens when we respond to problems without God.
