Lesson Nine • Matthew 9:35-10:7
The Gospel Demands

The Gospel of Jesus Christ:

Demands that His mission become OUR MISSION as His followers.

And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. Matthew 9:35

For His Mission to Become Our Mission:

We Need a Supernatural <u>AWARENESS</u> of the Condition of the Lost!

But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. Matthew 9:36

The Condition of the Lost:

- > See the SIZE of the lost multitudes of people.
- Feel the SUFFERING of the lost multitudes of people.
- > Realize the SEPARATION of the lost multitudes of people.

2. We Need a Sacrificial <u>OBEDIENCE</u> to the Commission of Jesus Christ!

The Commission of Jesus Christ:

Jesus calls us to PRAY.

"The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest." Matthew 9:37-38

Jesus commands us to GO.

And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.

Now the names of the twelve apostles are these... Matthew 10:1-2

These twelve Jesus sent out and commanded them, saying, "Do not go into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter a city of the Samaritans. But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.'" Matthew 10:5-7
