The Sanctity of Life

Abortion Is about God!

God is to be worshipfully PRAISED, for we are wonderfully MADE; and abortion is an assault on the supremacy of God to be praised by all people.

I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well. Psalm 139:14

Why We Uphold the Sanctity of Life in the Unborn

1. We Are Wonderfully MADE in the Image of God!

Key Question: What Is the Unborn?

We believe the unborn are distinct, living, and whole HUMAN BEINGS wonderfully made by God in His image from the moment of conception.

For You have formed my inward parts; you have covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well. My frame was not hidden from You, when I was made in secret, and skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, the days fashioned for me, when as yet there were none of them. Psalm 139:13-16

The Dark Works of Abortion:

- Abortion is an affront to God's AUTHORITY as Creator.
- Abortion is an assault on God's WORK in creation.
- Abortion is an attack on God's RELATIONSHIP with the unborn.

2. God Is to Be Worshipfully PRAISED by All People!

Praise the Lord! Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever. Psalm 106:1

Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting! And let all the people say, "Amen!" Praise the Lord! Psalm 106:48

Staggering Sins & Amazing Grace:

- The depth of HUMAN SIN is very great.

They did not destroy the peoples, concerning whom the Lord had commanded them, but they mingled with the Gentiles and learned their works; they served their idols, which became a snare to them. They even sacrificed their sons and their daughters to demons, and shed innocent blood, even the blood of their sons and daughters, whom they sacrificed to the idols of Canaan; and the land was polluted with blood. Thus they were defiled by their own works, and played the harlot by their own deeds. Psalm 106:34-39

The Sins of a Nation

Like the Children of Israel, we are sacrificing our children on the altar of abortion under the banner of choice and convenience.

- The depth of GOD'S GRACE is greater than all our sin.

Nevertheless He regarded their affliction, when He heard their cry; and for their sake He remembered His covenant, and relented according to the multitude of His mercies. Psalm 106:44-45

The Banner of the Cross

God is the Judge of sin and the Savior of sinners, which means grace and mercy are found at the Cross of Jesus Christ for those who repent.

Here We Stand

Upholding the sanctity of life in the unborn is all about GOD. God is to be worshipfully praised, for we are wonderfully made.
