To Trust Or Not to Trust

When It Comes to Giving to the Lord...

It's ultimately a matter of TRUSTING the Lord!

Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. 1Timothy 6:17 NIV

Two Principles for Trusting God in Your Giving:

1. When It Seems <u>IMPOSSIBLE</u> to Give, Trust God! 1Kings 17:8-16

When We Trust God and Give:

- We possess our POSSESSIONS.
- We prepare for the FUTURE.
- We place FAITH over sight.
- We put <u>GOD</u> to work on our behalf.

2. When It Seems <u>ILLOGICAL</u> to Give, Trust God! 2Corinthians 8:1-5

Four Lessons From the Macedonian Believers:

- > Giving is not about problems but priorities—so give FAITHFULLY.
- Giving is not about wealth but willingness—so give GENEROUSLY.
- Giving is not about obligation but opportunity—so give JOYFULLY.
- Giving is not about legalism but Lordship—so give <u>THANKFULLY</u>.

Three Words That Can Transform Your Life:
