Because of the Resurrection...

- > You can receive a RIGHTEOUSNESS you don't possess. 2Corinthians 5:21
- ▶ You can gain a SELF-CONTROL you don't practice. Romans 6:5-6
- You can avoid a JUDGMENT you can't prevent. *John 3:16-18*

1. The Resurrection of Christ Is RELIABLE!

"It is concerning the resurrection of the dead that I am on trial before you today." Acts 24:21 NIV

Evidence for the Resurrection of Christ:

 \geq EARLY accounts Acts 2:22-24, 32

- \geq EMPTY tomb John 20:6-8
- \geq EYEWITNESS testimony 1Corinthians 15:3-7

3. The Resurrection Christ Demands Of а **RESPONSE!**

Felix was afraid and said, "That's enough for now! You may leave. When I find it convenient, I will send for you." Acts 24:25 NIV

The Worst Thing You Can Do When Faced with a Spiritual Decision: To delay when your heart is CONVICTED by the truth.

The Danger of Delaying a Spiritual Decision:

It causes your heart to slowly CALLOUS toward Jesus.

"Today, if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts." Hebrews 4:7

What Are You Waiting For?

Respond today by TRUSTING Jesus as your Savior and Lord!

Seek the Lord while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near. Isaiah 55:6 Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation. 2Corinthians 6:2

If you're ready to respond, sincerely pray: "Lord Jesus, I know that I'm a sinner and that You are the Savior who died in my place and then rose again. I confess that You are Lord and I want to respond to You right now by surrendering my life to You. I receive You by faith. Please forgive me of my sins, come into my life, and make me into the person that pleases You. Amen."

2. The Resurrection of Christ Is RELEVANT!
