The Ten Commandments for Today

The Second Commandment • Exodus 20:4-6 Worshiping The Right God, The Right Way

What Kind of Legacy Are You Leaving Behind?

A legacy worth remembering keeps the <u>SECOND</u> commandment!

You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything...you shall not bow down to them or worship them. Exodus 20:4-5 NIV

What Is the Difference Between the First and Second Commandments? The first forbids false <u>GODS</u>, the second forbids false <u>WORSHIP</u>.

Worshiping the Right God, the Right Way:

1. The Command: Don't Worship a <u>SUBSTITUTE</u> for God!

You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; you shall not bow down to them or serve them. Exodus 20:4-5

What Is an "Idol"?

An "idol" is anything that <u>CAPTURES</u> the heart and is inflated to function as a substitute for God.

Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen. 1John 5:21

Why is worshiping a false image or substitute for God so dangerous?

We **<u>BECOME</u>** like that which we worship.

Those who make them [idols] will be like them, and so will all who trust in them. Psalm 115:8 NIV

What fault did your ancestors find in Me, that they strayed so far from Me? They followed worthless idols and became worthless themselves. Jeremiah 2:5 NIV

2. The Reason: God Is a <u>JEALOUS</u> God!

For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God... Exodus 20:5

Because of God's Holy Jealousy, Accept No Substitutes!

Worshiping the right God, the right way will <u>DELIGHT</u> you (fulfillment) and <u>DELIVER</u> you (freedom)!

Delight yourself also in the LORD, and He shall give you the desires of your heart. Psalm37:4 "If you abide in My word, you are truly My disciples, and you will know the truth,

and the truth will set you free." ~Jesus, John 8:31-32

What does the Second Commandment say about our worship today?

We must be very careful that the <u>VISUAL</u> never eclipses the <u>VERBAL</u> in our worship!

3. The Warning: The <u>CONSEQUENCES</u> of False Worship Will Last for Generations!

...visiting [punishing] the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me... Exodus 20:5

4. The Promise: The <u>BLESSINGS</u> of True Worship Will Last Forever!

...but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments. Exodus 20:5

What Can Save Us from Our Own Private Idolatries?

Rather than remaking God into <u>OUR</u> image, we need to be remade into <u>HIS</u> image through a saving relationship with His Son Jesus Christ!
