Lesson 10 · Isaiah 55:3

How Should We Respond to the Gospel According to Isaiah? SHOUT for Joy (Ch 54) and SHARE the News (Ch 55)!

How Can We Be SURE the LORD Will Satisfy Us?

Isaiah 55:3

The Lord Is Sure to Satisfy Our Souls

1. Because the Blessings of the New Covenant Are Made SURE by the Blood of the Lamb.

"And I will make an everlasting covenant with you," (55:3a)

What Is the "Everlasting Covenant"?

Option 1 The **DAVIDIC** Covenant that is *immediately* mentioned.

"I will make an everlasting covenant with you, my faithful love promised to David." NIV "And I will make an everlasting covenant with you—the sure mercies of David." NKJV

Option 2 The **NEW** Covenant *already* mentioned in Isaiah 54:10.

"And I will make an everlasting covenant with you, according to the faithful mercies shown to David." NASB "Then I will make an unconditional covenantal promise to you, just like the reliable covenantal promises I made to David." NET "I will make a permanent covenant with you on the basis of the faithful kindnesses of David." CSB

	The "Everlasting Covenant" and the "Covenant of Peace" Are the <u>NEW</u> Covenant!
Isaiah 54:8-10; 61:8	Isaiah speaks of a "Covenant of Peace" that is an "Everlasting Covenant" with New Covenant blessings (Isa 54 – 66).
Jeremiah 31:31-38 Jeremiah 32:40	The Prophet Jeremiah call this the "New Covenant" and explains its blessings that are sure to satisfy. In the very next chapter Jeremiah calls this New Covenant an Everlasting Covenant."
Ezekiel 34:25-26	Then we come to the Prophet Ezekiel promises "showers of blessings" due to a "Covenant of Peace."
Ezekiel 36:22-28	Then in Chapter 36 Ezekiel lists the blessings of the New Covenant like in Jeremiah 32.
Ezekiel 37:21-28	And the very next chapter Ezekiel calls this <i>New Covenant</i> a "Covenant of Peace" and an "Everlasting Covenant" with Israel regathered as one Nation under one King – "My Servant, David"!

What Are the Eternal Blessings of the New Covenant?

Jeremiah 31:31-38; 32:37-42; 33:11-18; Ezekiel 34:23-26; 36:22-28; 37:21-28; Isaiah 54:1-55:13 with Isaiah 56 –66.

- 1. New **START** Sins forgiven fully and finally!
- 2. New **HEART** Spiritual change from the inside out!
- 3. New **SPIRIT** Spirit-indwelling in the heart!
- 4. New **KINGDOM** Sure fulfillment of all God's promises to Israel, the Church, and the Nations!
- 5. New CREATION Supernatural renewal of the New Heavens and the New Earth!

Why Are These Blessings Sure to Satisfy Our Deepest Needs?

This is what will most SATISFY us.

This is what most GLORIFIES God.

This is what the Suffering Servant **PURCHASED** with His blood.

God is most glorified in us when we ae most satisfied in Him through the shed blood of His Suffering Servant!

2. Because the Blessings of the New Covenant Are Made SECURE by the Obedience of David.

"I will make a permanent covenant with you on the basis of the faithful kindnesses of David." (55:3b) CSB

Whose Covenant Loyalty Is the Basis for the New Covenant – the LORD or David?

- **Option 1** The acts of covenant faithfulness shown **TO** David by the LORD.
 - "And I will make an everlasting covenant with you, according to the faithful mercies shown to David." NAS
- **Option 2** The acts of covenant faithfulness shown **BY** David to the LORD.

"I will make a permanent covenant with you on the basis of the faithful kindnesses of David." CSB

The LORD showed acts of loyalty to David in the past but Isaiah is predicting the coming of a sinless Son of David who will show **PERFECT** covenant loyalty to the LORD!

2Samuel 7:8-16

What Are the Acts of Covenant Loyalty Shown by the Coming Son of David?

This DAVID faithfully and fully obeyed the Davidic Covenant and then offered Himself as the Lamb of God, so He could be the Mediator of the New Covenant Blessings!

Philippians 2:5-11; Revelation 1:4-7; Acts 13:22-23, 34, 38-39

Here Is an Invitation Too Sure to Doubt Come to the Son of David Who Is the Lamb of God that made your soul-satisfying salvation both sure and secure!

□ Be CONFIDENT in the Lord: He will surely satisfy you with His New Covenant blessings bought by the Lamb of God. Hebrews 9:15

Be DEPENDENT on the Lord: He will work in you what is pleasing to Him by the power of the Risen King. Hebrews 13:20
