Why Will the Exalted Son of David Succeed in Saving the Nations? Isaiah 55:4-5

1. BEHOLD! He is SELECTED to Be the Sovereign Savior for All Peoples.

"Behold, I have made him a witness to the peoples, a leader and commander for the peoples." (55:4)

The LORD Has Selected Him to Be...

His <u>FAITHFUL</u> Witness to All Peoples. "Behold, I have made him a witness to the peoples...." (v. 4)

Isaiah 49:6; 2Corinthians 1:19-20

His <u>VICTORIOUS</u> King for All Peoples.

"Behold, I have made him...a leader and commander for the peoples." (v. 4)

The future Son of David will be the Faithful Witness to the all the peoples, who testifies to them that He is the Victorious Ruler over all the peoples for their soul-satisfying salvation!

Revelation 1:5-7

2. BEHOLD! He Is <u>SENT</u> to Savingly Summon All the Unreached Nations.

"Behold, you will call a nation you do not know, and a nation which knows you not will run to you..." (55:5)

The LORD Sends, the King Calls, and the Nations Run!

The King's summons Is a <u>CALL</u> to all nations for salvation and service. "Behold, you will call a nation you do not know..."

Three Characteristics of His Call to Salvation

- 1. This is a VICTORIOUS call.
- 2. This is a GRACIOUS call. Isaiah 40:; 65:1-2; 61:1
- 3. This is an EFFICACIOUS call. Isaiah 48:12, 15; 51:2; 54:5

"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me;" John 10:27

The Nation's response is to <u>RUN</u> to Him in repentance and faith. "Behold...and a nation which knows you not will run to you..."

Three Characteristics of Their Run to Salvation

- 1. Their response is VOLUNTARY.
- 2. Their response is **NECESSARY**.
- 3. Their response is **EXTRAORDINARY**.

Why Does the King Call and Why Do the Nations Run to Him?

....because of the LORD your God, even the Holy One of Israel; for He has glorified you." (v. 5)

Here Is an Invitation Too Successful to Neglect

The Sovereign King Is Calling You Today, So Run to Him for Soul-satisfying Salvation!

- **BE SAVED by the King:** Answer His call and run to Him for salvation.
- LIVE AS A SERVANT of the King: Serve your Sovereign Savior from a heart of love and gratitude.
