1-3a	3b	4-5	6-9
SAVOR the FEAST!	SURE to SATISFY!	SENT to the NATIONS!	SEEK the LORD!
An Invitation Too Good to Refuse	An Invitation Too Sure to Question	An Invitation Too Successful to Neglect	An Invitation Too Urgent to Delay

Some invitations are too urgent to delay –especially if they are only offered for a **LIMITED TIME**! Isaiah 55:6-9

This is a limited-time offer too urgent to delay!

## Seek the LORD While There's Still Time!

1. WHO Needs to Seek the Lord? 55:6

## **EVERYONE** Needs to Seek the LORD!

Those who already know Him and those who don't know Him!

Why Should Those Who Already Know the Lord Still Seek Him? Isaiah 58

Too often we seek the **gift of salvation** but don't seek the **GIVER of salvation** for our day-to-day satisfaction in life!

## We All Need to Seek Him but for Different Reasons

- If you don't know the LORD, seek Him to **START** your relationship with Him.
- If you already know the LORD, seek Him to restore and **ENJOY** your fellowship with Him.

## 2. HOW Do We Seek the LORD? 55:6-7a

> CALL on the LORD for soul-saving satisfaction. (v. 6b)

"In the day of my trouble I shall call upon You, for You will answer me." Psalm 86:7
"But seeing the wind, [Peter] became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Matthew 14:30

**FORSAKE** your sin with humble repentance. (v. 7b) What Does It Mean to Forsake? Isaiah 54:6-8 What Are We to Forsake? "Sin will take you farther than you want to go, keep you longer than you want to stay, and cost you more than you want to pay." Why Must We to Forsake Our Sin in Humble Repentance? Because we can't seek the LORD and HOLD onto our sin at the same time! **RETURN** to the LORD with an expectant faith. Turning to the LORD Is the FLIP-SIDE of Repentance! We repent of our sins and turn to the Lord by grace through faith! Isaiah 65:1-3; Romans 10:20-21 3. WHY Seek the Lord Right Now? 55:7b-9 The Lord will welcome you home with abundant PARDON instead of well-deserved punishment. (v. 7b) The Lord Himself Tells Us Why Isaiah 55:8-9 My **HOLINESS** is *far higher* than you can imagine. My **FORGIVENESS** is *far greater* than you can imagine. The **GAP** between you and Me is *far wider* than you can ever bridge. Here Is an Invitation Too Urgent to Delay

Seek the Lord now while He is allowing Himself to be found and while He is still near to hear!

 □ Seek Him for your soul-saving satisfaction every day. Romans 10:11

☐ Share the Good News with everyone before it's too late. *Romans* 10:14-15
