RESPONSIBILITY! Faith Is Our Response to His Ability • Part 1 Lesson 13

The Crucial Question that Romans 9-11 Answers: Has God's Word—His saving promises to Israel—failed, in light of the fact that so many Jews have rejected Christ and are doomed to eternal punishment?

1. Romans 9...Wilderness of Frustration or Oasis of Worship?

- Romans 9 can be a wilderness of frustration & friction (especially we come to it from a *man-centered* perspective)...
 - 1) We look at the overwhelming rejection of Jesus Christ by Israel, God's chosen people, and begin to wonder if God's promises of to them have **FAILED**?

Paul's answer is clear: *NO!* God's promise of salvation for Jew or Gentile is **<u>ROOTED</u>** in God's sovereign, unconditional election! (9:6-13)

2) But that raises the question of **FAIRNESS**! Is God then unfair in choosing some to be saved based not on anything in them (birth, belief, or behavior) but solely on His own sovereign purpose in election?

Paul's answer is clear: NO! Unconditional election <u>**REFLECTS**</u> the perfection of God's character in all of its fullness. (9:14-18)

3) But if God is that sovereign in salvation and no one ultimately resists His will, doesn't that mean our choices are meaningless and everything is determined by <u>FATE</u>?

Paul's answer is clear: NO! Who are we to question God's sovereign <u>**RIGHT**</u> to accomplish His own purposes as our Creator and Redeemer? Unconditional election <u>**REVEALS**</u> the riches of God's glorious mercy against the backdrop of His longsuffering wrath. (9:19-29)

4) But doesn't God's sovereignty in unconditional election eliminate the need for FAITH?

Paul's answer is clear: NO! Unconditional election <u>**RESULTS**</u> in God's saving promises being fulfilled by grace through faith in Christ without eliminating human responsibility. (9:30-33; 11:1)

Romans 9 can be an oasis of wonder & worship (only when we come to it from a God-centered perspective)...

Romans 11:34-36

2. So <u>WHERE</u> Does Faith Come into the Picture (Order of Salvation?!)?

Not Where We Expect It to Come!

- ► We expect faith to come **EARLIER** (vv. 11, 15-16, 18)
- ► But Paul brings faith in LATER (vv. 30-33; 8:28-30)

What Shall "YOU" Say Then? (v. 19)

Natural conclusion of unbelief and/or human reasoning: It is all of God, SO there's NO room for human responsibility.

What Shall "We" Say Then? (vv. 30-33)

Biblical conclusion of belief in divine revelation: It is all of God AND there's STILL room for human responsibility.

- 3. Paul's Conclusions in Light of Unconditional Election [Especially God's Calling Out Many Gentiles and So Few Jews] (vv. 30-33)
 - ► God's sovereignty does not **ELIMINATE** human responsibility.

God's sovereignty and human responsibility **are not equals**, because the Bible clearly **exalts** God's sovereignty over human responsibility but does so in way that **does not eliminate** human responsibility!

1) It's a mystery.

2) This view of sovereignty not eliminating human responsibility is all over scripture...

Crucifixion of Christ - Acts 2:22–24; 4:27-29

Inspiration of Scripture - 2 Pet 1:20–21

Security of the Believer - 1 Peter 1:5

Sanctification of the Believer - Philippians 2:12-13

Salvation of the Believer - Acts 13:45-48; 2 Thessalonians 2:13-15
