Does Church Membership Matter? Yes!

Church membership MATTERS more than you probably think or realize.

For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. . . . Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it. 1 Corinthians 12:12, 27

Why We "Date" the Church

Our culture idolizes INDIVIDUALISM and fosters CONSUMERISM.

- Membership is implied by church <u>LEADERSHIP</u>. Acts 14:21-23 Hebrews 13:17
- Membership is implied by church <u>DISCIPLINE</u>. Matthew 18:15-18 1 Corinthians 5:1-13
- > Membership is implied by church <u>METAPHORS</u>.

3. Church Membership Is <u>GOOD</u> for Us and Glorifies God!

Biblical Benefits of Church Membership

- Membership is <u>AFFIRMATION</u> from the pastors.
- > Membership is <u>ASSURANCE</u> to the individual.
- Membership is <u>ACCOUNTABILITY</u> with the church.
- > Membership is <u>ANNOUNCEMENT</u> before the world.

2. Church Membership Is IMPLIED in God's Word!

Biblical Basis for Church Membership

Membership is implied by church <u>GATHERINGS</u>.

What Is Church Membership?

Membership in the local church involves a formal <u>COMMITMENT</u> with other believers who have joined together to fulfill the purposes of God to the glory of God.

1. Church Membership Is GOD'S Wonderful Idea!

From Universal to Local

The universal church includes <u>ALL CHRISTIANS</u> from all history. The local church is the <u>VISIBLE</u> expression of the universal body of Christ.

In the New Testament one's membership in the universal church is always visibly expressed through meaningful membership in a local church.
