Born to Be King

Why Start with a Genealogy?

To establish that Jesus is the legitimate sovereign <u>KING</u> promised by God.

The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

Matthew 1:1

The Genealogy of Jesus Christ

1. What Significance Does the Genealogy of Jesus Christ Have Today?

God Keeps His Promises

- > Jesus came from the right LINE of Abraham and David (vs. 2-16).
- > Jesus came at the right <u>TIME</u> in human history (vs. 17).

2. Who Is Included in the Genealogy of Jesus Christ?

Three Types of People Are Included

- ➤ God includes the <u>FAITHFUL</u> in Jesus Christ's genealogy.
- God includes the FAILURES in Jesus Christ's genealogy.
- ➤ God includes the <u>FORGOTTEN</u> in Jesus Christ's genealogy.

3. Why Would God Include These Types of People in the Genealogy of Jesus Christ?

Three Possible Answers

- ➤ God did it to send a MESSAGE to self-righteous people.
- God did it so that His GRACE might be richly displayed.
- God did it so we would focus on JESUS CHRIST.

The Good News from Jesus' Genealogy

No matter who you are or what you've done, Jesus came to <u>SAVE</u> you from your sins and to be your King.
