Our Heart Cry for Daily Bread Is a Daily Reminder

1. WHO Our Provider Really Is. “Give us”

“Give us” reminds us that **EVERYTHING** we have is a gift from God!

Who Really Is Our Provider?

- It’s my **GOD** not myself! James 1:17

Myth #1 “I **PROVIDE/EARN** it!” Deuteronomy 8:17-18

Myth #2 “God provides it, but I **DESERVE** it!” Deuteronomy 9:4-7

- It’s our **FATHER** not ourselves! Matthew 6:8; 6:31-33; 7:7-11

Five Marks of a Disciple Who Really Knows God the Father Is His or Her Provider

1. **PRAYERFULNESS:** We pray like this on a daily basis. 1Chronicles 29:10-16
2. **THANKFULNESS:** We give thanks on a daily basis. 1Timothy 4:3-5
3. **CONTENTEDNESS:** We are content with what God has given us on a daily basis. 1Timothy 6:7-8
4. **FAITHFULNESS:** We give back to God the first part of all that He has given us on a weekly basis. 1Corinthians 16:2
5. **UNSELFISHNESS:** We share with those in need on a daily basis. James 2:15-16

2. WHAT the Father’s Provision Really Is. “bread”

Our Father in Heaven Provides

- What’s necessary to *sustain* our **PHYSICAL** lives. Exodus 16:3-15
- What’s necessary to *satisfy* our **SPIRITUAL** lives. Deuteronomy 8:3; Matthew 4:4; John 6:26-27
- What’s necessary to *secure* our **ETERNAL** lives. John 6:30-66

3. HOW the Father Chooses to Provide It. “this day...daily”

- What is **NECESSARY**. *Exodus 16:16-18*

- What is necessary for **TODAY**. *Exodus 16:19-21, 6-7*

- What is necessary for today in light of **ETERNITY**. *Deuteronomy 8:3; Matthew 4:4*

“Give me today what I need to live for eternity!”

4. WHY the Father Chooses to Provide It the Way He Does. “our”

- Daily bread is a **TEST** of our *faithfulness* to the Lord.
Exodus 16:4-5; Deuteronomy 8:2-6; Matthew 4:4; Proverbs 30:8-9

- 1. Some tried to gather **MORE** manna than God commanded. *Exodus 16:20*

- 2. Some tried to gather manna **AT TIMES** that God prohibited. *Exodus 16:27-30*

- Daily bread is a **TESTIMONY** of His *faithfulness* to us. *Exodus 16:32-36; Psalm 37:25-26; 1Corinthians 11:24*
Exodus 16:32-36; Psalm 37:25-26; 1Corinthians 11:24

The Lord Always Provides Our Daily Bread!

We must trust Him to do His part as we obey Him which is our part!

Are You Daily Passing the Test of Your Faithfulness to Him?

Do your attitudes and actions reveal *on a daily basis* that you know *WHO* your provider really is?

Do you ask Him to meet your *physical, spiritual, and eternal needs* on a daily basis?

Are you *living one day at a time* and *trusting Him* to get you through your trials and temptations *one day at a time*?

Are You Daily Reflecting on the Testimony of His Faithfulness to You?

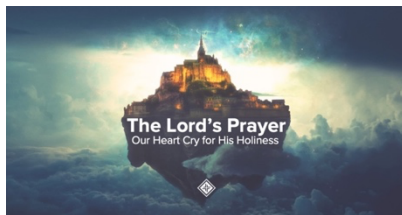

Do I Depend on My Father as My Daily Provider?

When we daily pray *"Give us this day our daily bread"* we will daily remember *WHO* our provider really is, *WHAT* the Father actually provides, *HOW* He provides it, and *WHY* he provides it the way He does
