How Does This Heart Cry Tie Together?

"And do not lead us into temptation but deliver us from the evil one!"

Protect Us in Temptation and Protect Us from the Tempter The AVOIDANCE of sin and DELIVERANCE from Satan!

Daily deliverance from sin **BEGINS** with daily dependence on God when tempted!

Our Heart Cry for Daily Deliverance by Daily Dependence 1. What Does "Lead Us Not into Temptation" Mean?

"Lead" = To bring into the presence of someone or something.

"Temptation" = A trial, a test, or a temptation

> The Father **SOMETIMES** leads us into temptation.

Jesus – Matthew 4:1-11

Job – Job 1:6-12

Peter – Luke 22:31-32

God allows us to be tempted, but He Himself is not the Author of our temptations. He permits sin; He never promotes it!

The Father <u>NEVER</u> brings us into temptation to tempt us but to test us.

Difference Between God's Testing and Satan's Tempting

- 1. Every trial is **BOTH** a test from God and a temptation from the devil.
- 2. Every trial is a choice be either APPROVED by God or ACCUSED by the devil!

God's Purpose in Testing	Satan's Purpose in Tempting
To reward us for enduring	To accuse us before God.
To refine us for eternity.	To slander us before God.
To reassure us for encouragement.	To condemn us before God.
To reveal us for evaluation.	To enslave us before God.

Every trial is either a **TRIUMPH** for God's kingdom or Satan's kingdom.

2. Why Daily Pray "Lead Us Not into Temptation"?

- > Because we are WEAK: Pray for Avoidance!
 - 1. Prayerful Dependence: AVOIDANCE of temptation. Matthew 26:40-41; Luke 22:40
 - 2. Prayerless Arrogance: **ENTRANCE** into temptation. Matthew 26:31-41

Remember Your Master's Warning "Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak."

- > The enemy is **<u>STRONG</u>**: Pray for Deliverance!
 - 1. Prayerful Dependence: DELIVERANCE in temptation. 1Peter 5:8; Ephesians 6:12
 - 2. Prayerless Arrogance: Will not ESCAPE temptation or ENDURE it without sinning. 1Corinthians 10:13
- ➢ God is STRONGER: Pray with Confidence!
 - 1. Prayerful Dependence: CONFIDENCE about temptation. 1 Corinthians 10:13

"Dearest Father, do not bring us into the place of temptation because we are weak, the enemy is strong, but You are stronger!

Confidence Due to ...

- Trusting in the Father's **Person**, **His Risen Son**, not us.
- Trusting in the Father's *promises*, not ours.
- Trusting in in the Father's *power*, not ours.
- 2. Prayerless of Arrogance: CONQUERED by temptation and CAUGHT in the Tempter's trap!

My Heart Cry for Our Daily Deliverance!

"And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one." Matthew 6:13

Because we are *weak*, our enemy is *strong* but our Father is *stronger*, we can pray with in *Christ confidence* for the *avoidance of* temptation and the *deliverance in* temptation.
