Where Does the Lord's Prayer End?

1. The Question Everyone Should Ask: Is It BIBLE?

- **Translations:** *Editors are doubtful it was part of the original autographs.*

ENDING of the LORD'S PRAYER – Matthew 6:13b			
OMITTED <i>with Note in Margin</i> ESV, CSB, NIV11, NET	INCLUDED <i>with Brackets and Note in Margin</i> NASB	INCLUDED <i>with Note in Margin</i> NKJV	INCLUDED <i>Without Note</i> KJV

- **Texts:** *Evidence is somewhat divided among the manuscript copies but earliest don't include it.*
- **Testimony:** *Early Church is diverse but with early use in church worship.*
- **Teachers:** *Evangelical majority decidedly teach it was not part of the inspired original of Matthew's Gospel.*

2. An Answer Everyone Affirms: It Is BIBLICAL!

*A doxology is a "word of glory" that makes God look as **GLORIOUS** as He reveals Himself to be.*
1Timothy 6:13-16; 2Timothy 4:18; Revelation 4:10-11; 5:11-14

"So David blessed the LORD in the sight of all the assembly; and David said, 'Blessed are You, O LORD God Of Israel our father, forever and ever. Yours, O LORD, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty, indeed everything that is in the heavens and the earth; Yours is the dominion, O LORD, and You exalt Yourself as head over all. Both riches and honor come from You, and You rule over all, and in Your hand is power and might; and it lies in Your hand to make great and to strengthen everyone. Now therefore, our God, we thank You, and praise Your glorious name.'" 1Chronicles 29:10-13

"Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy, to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen." Jude 24-25

Why Would God Allow This to Happen?

- To **REMIND** us He is sovereign over the Scriptures.
- To **RELEASE** us to respond with our own heart cry.

Jesus' Prayer Ends When Our Praise **BEGINS!**

This is *"the song of the heart that prays after the Lord's pattern of prayer!"* – Kent Hughes

The Ending of the Lord's Prayer and the Beginning of the Lord's Day

*The Beginning of the Lord's Day Makes the Ending of the Lord's Prayer a Forever **REALITY.***

1. All the Kingdoms Belong to the SON Who Is Risen Forever!

- Jesus' *past* **RESURRECTION** proves His kingship. *Acts 2:22-24, 32-36; Romans 1:4*
- Jesus *presently* **REIGNS** with all authority in heaven and on earth. *Acts 2:34-35 Matthew 28:18*
- Jesus' *future* **RETURN** will reveal His Kingdom on earth. *Acts 2:34-35; Revelation 12:10; 11:15-17; 19:11-16; 8:3-5*

*"Yours, not ours, is the kingdom we **eagerly seek** forever!"*

2. All the Power Comes from the SPIRIT Who Is Given Forever!

- The Risen King **GIVES** the Spirit of God to His People. *Acts 2:32-33*
- The Holy Spirit gives us Jesus' **RESURRECTION** power to do what pleases the Father. *Ephesians 1:18-21*

*"Yours, not ours, is the power we **desperately need** forever!"*

3. All the Glory Goes to the FATHER Who Is Proven Worthy Forever!

"For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive. But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, after that those who are Christ's at His coming, then *comes* the end, when He hands over the kingdom to the God and Father, when He has abolished all rule and all authority and power. For [Christ] must reign until [the Father] has put all [Christ's] enemies under His feet. The last enemy that will be abolished is death. For He has put all things in subjection under His feet. But when He says, "All things are put in subjection," it is evident that [the Father] is excepted who put all things in subjection to [Christ]. When all things are subjected to [Christ], then the Son Himself also will be subjected to the One who subjected all things to Him, so that God may be all in all." **1Corinthians 15:22-28**

The Lord's Prayer originally had *no ending* because we are to supply the ending with our own heart cry. The Lord's Prayer *ends* when our praise *begins*!

Write your own personal heart cry to the Father in response to what you have learned about giving the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit all the glory.

Take what you wrote and pray it back to your heavenly Father.

Pray "Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen!"

1. Praise God the Son who is risen from the dead as the King of kings and Lord of Lords. All authority in heaven and on earth is His.
