## ALTERED: Encounters with Jesus

*Lesson Twelve • Mark 5:21-43*  
**Two Desperate People**

### **Two Desperate People**

Jesus proves He is Lord over DISEASE and even DEATH.

Jesus has authority over what is impossible for us. Demons, disease, and death surrender completely and immediately to His sovereign authority.

### **Two Desperate People Encounter Jesus**

## **1. A Desperate Intercession: Jesus HEARS the Plea of a Distressed Father!**

### ***Jesus and a Distressed Father***

- A desperate REQUEST by a father: "My daughter is dying! Come and heal her!" (vs. 21-23)
- A compassionate RESPONSE by Jesus: "He went with him." (vs. 24)

## **2. A Desperate Interruption: Jesus STOPS the Suffering of a Diseased Woman!**

### ***Jesus and a Diseased Woman***

- The HORROR she endured was prolonged for 12 years (vs. 25-26).
- The HOPE she embraced was desperate but determined (vs. 27-28).

- The HEALING she experienced was powerful, personal and profound (vs. 29-34).

## **3. A Dramatic Intervention: Jesus RAISES a Little Girl from the Dead!**

### ***Jesus and a Dead Daughter***

- Believe in Jesus in spite of the CIRCUMSTANCES (vs. 35-36).
- Believe in Jesus regardless of the SKEPTICS (vs. 37-40).
- Believe in Jesus because He has authority over DEATH (vs. 41-43).

### **Take-Away from Two Desperate People**

Jesus cares for those who are facing desperate situations in life.  
So TURN to Jesus and TRUST Him in your desperation.

### **COMMUNION**

#### **Remembering Jesus' Death to Give Us Life**

Followers of Jesus Christ (those who trust Christ for salvation, identify with Christ in baptism, and commit to Christ's body in membership of a local church of like faith and practice) are invited to participate in Communion located at the four tables in the auditorium. You may take the bread and cup back to your seat to eat and drink. The bread and juice represent the body and blood of Jesus when He died on the Cross and reminds us who our Lord is, what He has
