Nowhere to Run, Nowhere to Hide!

What's Eating Jonah?

A heart problem in relation to God's COMPASSION for the lost!

The Missionary Problem Is Always a <u>HEART</u> Problem!

Is my heart *running* from the Great Commission?

Running Like Jonah from the Great Commission

- 1. We Often Run from OBEYING the Great Commission.
 - We run from **RESPONSIBILITY** to represent God. (1:3, 10)
 - 1. God commissioned Jonah to **GO** reach Nineveh. (vv. 1-2)
 - God has commissioned <u>EVERY</u> believer to go reach the unreached.
 Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 1:8
 - We run from <u>ACCOUNTABILITY</u> to fulfill His commission! (1:3-12; 3:2)

What Happens When We Run?

- 1. We run in the **OPPOSITE** direction of obedience.
- 2. We run **DOWN** into greater disobedience.
- 3. We run in **REBELLION** against God.

What has God called you to **do** to reach this world for Christ? What has He commissioned you to **become** to solve the missionary problem?

2. We Run Because We LACK Great Compassion.

Why Do We Lack Great Compassion?

- We love **OURSELVES** more than we love God and the lost.

 John 3:16: Matthew 22:37-40
- We **FEAR** people more than we fear God. (1:5, 9-10, 16)
- ➤ We **LOVE** people less than God loves them! (4:2-3)

3. We Run but There's No Place to HIDE from Our Great God.

- We can't hide from the **COMPASSION** of the LORD. (1:4-5)

 Psalm 139:7-12
- We can't hide from the **CRIES** of the lost. (1:6-11)
- ➤ We can't hide from the **CONSEQUENCES** of running. (1:12-17)

When we try to run from our commission to reach the world, we will only run into the discipline of our sovereign and compassionate God!

We will reap what we sow: God's **DISCIPLINE!**

The lost are left to reap what they sow: God's **WRATH!**

"Salvation belongs to the LORD!" Jonah 1:17: 2:9: Matthew 12:39-40
