A Healthy Church

Is one where EVERYONE in the church
is re-engaging the church.

*I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling
to which you have been called. Ephesians 4:1*

What Does a Healthy Church Look Like?

1. A Healthy Church Is Marked by UNITY in Salvation!

Unity in Salvation

We are united by the Gospel CONFESSION of one body, one Spirit,
one hope, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father (vs. 4-6).

2. A Healthy Church is Marked by DIVERSITY in Gifts!

Diversity in Gifts

- Christ gave you the GIFTS that He knows our church needs (vs. 7-10).
- Our church is entrusted with pastors to "EQUIP the saints" (vs. 11-12).
- You are equipped to SERVE in the "work of ministry" (vs. 12).

Opportunities to Serve in the Work of Ministry

- Community Block Party this Saturday, August 28 – sign-up to serve at Info Center at back of Auditorium
- Nursery – serve one Sunday a month during the Worship Service

- Kids Ministries – serve during Discovery Hour assisting or teaching kids or during the Worship Service in Kingdom Kids or Wednesdays nights in Awana Clubs & Trek
- Student Ministry – serve during Discovery Hour assisting or teaching middle and high school students
- First Impressions Ministry – serve as a greeter for the Worship Service one or two Sundays a month (Equipping meeting on Sunday, September 12 @ 9:30 AM in Multipurpose Room)
- Hospitality Ministry – make coffee for the adult and student classes in Discovery Hour
- GrowGroup – use your house to host a GrowGroup
- Media Booth – serve on the audio/visual team during the Worship Service
- Lawn Care – help mow and trim the grass on a rotation basis
- Praise Team – use your instrumental or vocal abilities in the Worship Service (requires reasonable level of proficiency)
