JOEL: Turn to the Lord

Lesson Two • Joel 2:1-17

The Alarm Sounds

Sound the Alarm!

God is calling us to take <u>SERIOUSLY</u> the impact of His coming judgment knowing that it can only be endured by turning to Him with torn hearts.

Blow a trumpet in Zion; sound an alarm on My holy mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble, for the day of the LORD is coming; it is near. Joel 2:1

"Yet even now," declares the LORD, "return to Me with all your heart." Joel 2:12

The Alarm Sounds

1. TREMBLE Before the God Who Judges in Righteousness! $\frac{1}{\sqrt{5}}$

First Trumpet Blast: The Day of the Lord Is Near!

This is God's <u>WARNING</u> that judgment is coming (vs. 1).

God warns us because He loves us.

The Day of the Lord

- It is day of thick DARKNESS (vs. 2, 10).
- It is day of horrible DEVASTATION (vs. 3).
- It is a day of foreboding DREAD (vs. 4-11).

2. TURN Back to the God Who Relents in Lovingkindness!

Second Trumpet Blast: The Mercy of the Lord Is Here!

This is God's gracious and merciful <u>INVITATION</u> for His people to gather together to repent of sin and depend on Him for deliverance from His coming judgment (vs. 15-16).

Turning Back to the Lord in Repentance

- The mark of repentance is a torn HEART, not garments (vs. 12-13).
- The grounds of repentance is the Lord's CHARACTER (vs. 13-14).
- The assurance of repentance is the Lord's NAME and glory (vs. 17).

The Day of the Lord Is Coming! Are You Prepared?

The coming Day of the Lord should lead us to turn to <u>JESUS CHRIST</u> in repentance of sin and dependence on Him for our salvation.

And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved.

Joel 2:32
