Who Needs Jesus?

Nicodemus and the woman at the well shows that EVERYONE, everywhere needs Jesus regardless of their gender, status, or nationality.

Jesus Encounters the Woman at the Well

1. Jesus Tells the Woman at the Well the Wonderful Truth about HIMSELF!

The Truth about Jesus

- Jesus is graciously PURPOSEFUL (vs. 1-4).
- Jesus is graciously RELATIONAL (vs. 5-9).
- Jesus is graciously SUPERIOR (vs. 10-14).

2. Jesus Tells the Woman at the Well the Woeful Truth about HERSELF!

The Truth about Ourselves

- Our guilty past can cause PRESENT PAIN (vs. 15).
- Our core problem is SPIRITUAL THIRST (vs. 16-19).
- Only Jesus can satisfy our DEEPEST NEED (vs. 10, 13-14).

No Second-Hand Faith

You can't be saved on second-hand faith. You must BELIEVE in Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord.

*Many Samaritans from that town BELIEVED in Him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me all that I ever did." So when the Samaritans came to Him, they asked Him to stay with them, and He stayed there two days. And many more BELIEVED because of His word. They said to the woman, "It is no longer because of what you said that we BELIEVE, for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is indeed the Savior of the world."
John 4:39-42*
