Lesson 3 • Genesis 27:41; 36:1-43

Edom's Family Tree Is Rooted in Fleshly Living

Living to feed the flesh **<u>FORFEITS</u>** the blessings of God and leaves a **<u>LEGACY</u>** of feeding the flesh instead of walking in the Spirit.

A Family Feud Between the Flesh and the Spirit

▶ Battle of the Bulge – Genesis 25:19-23

The LORD said to her, "Two nations are in your womb; And two peoples will be separated from your body; And one people shall be stronger than the other; And the older shall serve the younger." Genesis 25:23

- Birth of the Boys Genesis 25:24-26
- Bargain for the Birthright Genesis 25:27-34

"Then Jacob gave Esau bread and lentil stew; and he ate and drank, and rose and went on his way. Thus Esau despised his birthright." Genesis 25:34

BITTERNESS over the Blessing – Genesis 27:29-41

The Only Blessing that Was Left for Esau Was an "Unblessing"

- 1. Live **<u>AWAY</u>** from the good land.
- 2. Live by the **SWORD**.
- 3. **<u>SERVE</u>** your brother, Jacob = *Israel*.
- 4. **<u>REBEL</u>** against your brother's rule over you.

"So Esau bore a grudge against Jacob because of the blessing with which his father had blessed him; and Esau said to himself, "The days of mourning for my father are near; then I will kill my brother Jacob." Genesis 27:41

The Legacy of Esau's Fleshly Lifestyle in Edom

1. His Fleshly CHILDREN: The House of Esau Genesis 36:1-5; Obadiah 18

- Wives according to the flesh. *Genesis* 36:1-3; 26:34-35; 28:8-9
- Children according to the flesh. Genesis 36:4-5, 10-19, 31-43
- 2. His Fleshly COUNTRY: The Land of Edom Genesis 36:6-8; Obadiah 3
 - Location of Mount Seir. Numbers 34:3; Joshua 15:1, 21; Numbers 24:17-19
 - > LORD gave the land to the Edomites as their possession. Deuteronomy 2:12, 19-22
 - Lay of the Land. Obadiah 3



- 3. His Fleshly CITIES: The Mountains of Esau Genesis 36:11; Obadiah 8-9
 - **Bozrah** in the north with its fleshly **WEALTH**.
 - > Teman in the south with its fleshly WISDOM. Obadiah 8-9
 - Sela, the capital, with its fleshly WARFARE/ STRENGTH. Obadiah 3

4. His Fleshly <u>CONFLICT</u>: The Family Feud with Israel

- The covenant **RELATIONSHIP** by brotherly blood between Edom and Israel. *Deuteronomy 23:7; 2:4-6*
- > The covenant **RESPONSIBILITY** to bless his brother, Israel. Genesis 12:1-3; 27:27-29
- > The covenant **REBELLION** by Edom against his brother, *Israel*, results in a bitter national rivalry.

The Family Feud Becomes a Bitter National Rivalry: First Example of Many

- 1. Edom is **TERRIFIED** by the news of Israel's exodus from Egypt! *Exodus 15:14-18*
- 2. Edom proudly <u>**REFUSES**</u> Israel's humble request to pass peacefully through their country on their way to the Promised Land! Numbers 20:14-21
- 3. Edom is CURSED yet again for proudly refusing to help his brother, Israel. Numbers 24:17-19

Lessons from the Legacy of Esau's Fleshly Lifestyle in Edom

- □ The Lord GOD **<u>REVEALS</u>** His Big Story in the Bible so we could see our story in His Story.
- The Lord GOD **<u>REMINDS</u>** us that His sovereignty is *not equal* to human responsibility but is *exalted over* it *without eliminating* it.
- □ The Lord GOD takes covenant keeping **<u>REALLY</u>** seriously and so should we.
 - Covenant of family by birth or adoption
 - Covenant of marriage by vows
 - Covenant of salvation by faith in the Humble Suffering Servant and Exalted Sovereign Savior: Jesus Christ our LORD!
