Welcoming and Greeting Will Help Paul PURSUE Gospel Mobilization!

Receiving outsiders **ENCOURAGES** gospel unity and recognizing proven workers **EMPOWERS** gospel mobilization.

Gospel Mobilization

Empowering others to **DISCOVER** the diverse ways God has shaped them to fulfill the Great Commission through the local church.

The Priorities of Gospel Mobilization

1. Mobilize with Gospel EQUALITY.

"in the Lord" (6x), "in Christ (Jesus)" (4x), "to Christ" (1x), "of Christ" (1x)

2. Mobilize with Gospel DIVERSITY.

Gospel Diversity Looks Like ...

- RACIAL diversity
- 2. **FAMILY** diversity
- FINANCIAL diversity
- 4. **SOCIAL** diversity
- 5. **SPIRITUAL** diversity
- 6. VOCATIONAL diversity

3. Mobilize with Gospel COMPLEMENTARITY.

Complementarity: Men and women are equal in value but different in their roles in the home and the church. They complement and complete one another in differing roles.

Egalitarianism: Men and women are equal in everything and every way. Therefore, men and women can fulfill the same roles in marriage and ministry.

37 people mentioned in the whole chapter including 10 women.
7 of these women are described with ministry terms.
3 of these are in the eye of the storm over women's roles in ministry:
Phoebe (v. 1), Prisca/Priscilla (v. 3), Junia (v. 7)

Paul Values, Honors, and Celebrates Women in Ministry, So Should We!

- Saints in the Lord (v. 2)
- **Sisters** in Christ (v. 2, cf. v 15)
- Spouses & Singles: Spouses (vv. 3, 13); Singles [?] (vv. 2, 13, 15)
- Servants of Christ, Christians, & Churches (vv. 1, 4, 6, 12)
- Supporters of Christians/Churches as well as Missionaries/Missions (vv, 1, 5)
- Sent Ones as Missionaries (vv. 7[?])
- **Sharers** of Heart & Home (vv. 5, 13, 15)
- Sacrifices Living in the Lord's Service (vv, 3-4, 6-7, 12; cf. 12:1-2)

But **none** are **Shepherds** in the role of Pastors/Elders/Overseers who lead and teach the local church with authority. (See 1Timothy 2:11-15; 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9.)

As Complementarians, What Do We Need to Remember from Romans 16?

4. Mobilize with Gospel UNITY. Romans 16:16

- > Stay united **WITHIN** the local church: "Greet on another with a holy kiss!"
- Stay united BETWEEN local churches: "All the churches of Christ greet you!"

Mobilizing God's people to advance the gospel in hard places calls for diversity and unity in Christ even in hard times.
