God's Merciful Invitation

In light of God's coming judgment, we are <u>INVITED</u> to seek God's saving grace before it's too late or face destruction.

Gather together, yes, gather, O shameless nation, before the decree takes effect—before the day passes away like chaff—before there comes upon you the burning anger of the LORD, before there comes upon you the day of the anger of the LORD. Seek the LORD, all you humble of the land, who do His just commands; seek righteousness; seek humility; perhaps you may be hidden on the day of the anger of the LORD. Zephaniah 2:1-3

How to Respond to God's Merciful Invitation

1. GATHER Together to Worship the Lord!

Gather together, yes, gather, O shameless nation. Zephaniah 2:1

Why Gather Together?

A return to corporate <u>WORSHIP</u> is often necessary to bring us to the point of recalling and repenting.

Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out. Acts 3:19

Recalling and Repenting

Recalling is the <u>ACKNOWLEDGMENT</u> of our sin.

Repenting is the <u>GATEWAY</u> to God's saving grace.

2. <u>SEEK</u> the Lord Before It's Too Late!

Seek the Lord, all you humble of the land, who do His just commands; seek righteousness; seek humility... Zephaniah 2:3

Don't Wait to Seek the Lord

Now is the time to <u>HEED</u> God's warning and seek the Lord's face and saving grace before it's too late.

Before the decree takes effect—before the day passes away like chaff—before there comes upon you the burning anger of the LORD, before there comes upon you the day of the anger of the LORD. Zephaniah 2:2

Why Seek the Lord?

So you may be <u>HIDDEN</u> in the Lord on the day of the Lord's wrath.

...perhaps you may be hidden on the day of the anger of the LORD. Zephaniah 2:3

How to Seek the Lord

- Seek the Lord in <u>HUMILITY</u>.
- Seek the Lord in <u>OBEDIENCE</u>.
- Seek the Lord in <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>.

Time Is Running Out!
