Edom: The Legacy of Feeding the Flesh • Part 2

Lesson 4 • Obadiah 10

Edom's Family Tree Is Rooted in Fleshly Living

Living to feed the flesh forfeits the blessings of God and leaves a legacy of feeding the flesh instead of walking in the Spirit.

The Family Feud Becomes a Bitter National Rivalry between Edom and Judah

1. **2000 BC** Esau and Jacob are *twin brothers born* to Isaac and Rebekah.

A Family Feud Between the Flesh and the Spirit

- Battle of the BULGE (Genesis 25:19-23)
- Birth of the BOYS (25:24-28)
- Bargain for the BIRTHRIGHT (25:29-34)
- Bitterness Over the BLESSING (Genesis 27:1-41)

The Legacy of Esau's Fleshly Living

- His Fleshly CHILDREN: The House of Esau (Genesis 36:1-3; Obadiah 18)
- His Fleshly COUNTRY: The Possession of Esau (Numbers 34:3; Joshua 15:1, 21; Obadiah 3)
- His Fleshly CITIES: The Mountains of Esau (Numbers 34:3; Joshua 15:1, 21; Obadiah 3, 8-9)
- His Fleshly CONFLICT: The Family Feud and National Rivalry with Israel

Edom's Covenant RELATIONSHIP as Blood Brothers with Israel (Deuteronomy 23:7; 2:4-6) Edom's Covenant RESPONSIBILITY to Behave Brotherly and Bless Israel (Genesis 12:1-3; 27:29) Edom's Covenant REBELLION Results in Bitter National Rivalry

"Because of violence to your brother Jacob, you will be covered with shame, and you will be cut off forever." Obadiah 10



- 2. **1400 BC** Edom *proudly* <u>REFUSES</u> to grant Moses and redeemed Israel safe passage through their country. *Numbers* 20:14-21; 24:17-19
- 3. **1020-1000 BC** King Saul <u>PUNISHES</u> *Edom* for helping Israel's enemies plunder his bother-nation. *1Samuel 14:47-48; 21:7–22:22*

OPTION 1 – Judah's Day of Discipline Predicted in Obadiah 10-14.

- 4. **1010–970 BC** King David <u>CONQUERS</u> Edom and they must serve their younger brother, Israel. 2Samuel 8:13-15; 1Kings 11:15-17
- 5. **971-931 BC** King Solomon RULES OVER Edom until he becomes proud and makes fleshly compromises like Esau. 1Kings 9:1-9; 11:1-17
 - The Humble Condition of Yahweh's Blessing (9:1-9)
 - The Proud Compromise of Solomon's Flesh (11:1-8)
 - > The Humbling Consequences of Discipline from LORD of His Son, the Davidic King. (11:14-17)

7.	853-841 BC	Edom REVOLTS during the reign of <i>King Jehoram</i> and throws off the yoke of his brothe
		Judah. 2Kings 8:16-24; 2Chronicles 21:1-10; 22:1; Obadiah 10-14

OPTION 2 - Judah's Day of Discipline Predicted in Obadiah 10-14.

- 8. **796–767 BC** King Amaziah of Judah **RE-CONQUERS** Edom. 2Kings 14:5, 7-14; 2Chronicales 25:11-12, 14-28
- 9. **735–715 BC** Edom RAIDS Judah again during the reign of King Ahaz. 2Chronicles 28:16-21 OPTION 3 Judah's Day of Discipline Predicted in Obadiah 10-14.
- 10. **586 BC** *Edom* <u>REJOICES</u> over the *Fall of Jerusalem* and *Judah's exile* into Babylonian captivity. *Psalm* 137:7; Ezekiel 35:1-15; Jeremiah 9:23-26

OPTION 4 - Judah's Day of Discipline Predicted in Obadiah 10-14.

- 11. **312 BC Edom OVERTHROWN** by Nabatean Arabs and remains "cut off by slaughter" to this day. Obadiah 1-10
- 12. **37/6–4 BC** *Herod the Great,* an Idumean, becomes *"King of the Jews"* in Judea under the Romans. *Matthew 2:1-23; Mark 3:8*
- 13. **70 AD Idumeans join the Jews** in a revolt against Rome to defend the Jerusalem Temple but they are put down, the Temple is burned, and the **"Edomites"** no longer exist.

"Then your mighty men will be dismayed, O Teman, So that everyone may be cut off from the mountain of Esau by slaughter." Obadiah 9

More Lessons from the Legacy of Esau's Fleshly Lifestyle in Edom

- ☐ The *Promise Keeping God* always **KEEPS** His word to discipline then deliver His covenant people. "The vision of Obadiah. Thus says the Lord GOD concerning Edom —" Obadiah 1
- ☐ The Sovereign Lord <u>USES</u> pagan nations to humble proud nations that break His commandments and do violence to one another and to His covenant people.

"and an envoy has been sent among the nations saying," Obadiah 1

☐ The Sovereign Lord is the Promise Keeping God who will finally and fully keep <u>ALL</u> His promises to destroy and deliver...you can count on it!

"Arise and let us go against her for battle—" Obadiah 1
