Woe to the Nations

Woe to the Nations

The whole <u>WORLD</u> stands under God's sovereign rule; He is the ultimate Judge of all the nations. Therefore, it's useless to seek refuge from God's judgment in other nations and their impotent gods.

Seek the LORD, all you humble of the land, who do His just commands; seek righteousness; seek humility; perhaps you may be hidden on the day of the anger of the LORD. For...

Zephaniah 2:3-4

Woe to the Nations on the Day of the Lord

1. God Will JUDGE the Gentile Nations Justly!

The Judgment of Gentile Nations

- God will judge PHILISTIA in the West (vs. 4-7).
- God will judge MOAB and AMMON in the East (vs. 8-11).
- God will judge CUSH in the South (vs. 12).
- God will judge ASSYRIA in the North (vs. 13-15).

Judgment Justified

These nations will be judged by God because of their <u>PRIDE</u> against God and His people.

"I have heard the taunts of Moab and the revilings of the Ammonites, how they have taunted My people and made boasts against their territory." Zephaniah 2:8

This shall be their lot in return for their pride, because they taunted and boasted against the people of the LORD of hosts. Zephaniah 2:10

This is the exultant city that lived securely, that said in her heart, "I am, and there is no one else." Zephaniah 2:15

2. God CARES for His People Steadfastly!

The Steadfast Love of God

- God's judgment includes the promise of RESTORATION (vs. 6-7).
- God's judgment includes the promise of VINDICATION (vs. 9).

3. God Offers HOPE to Believers Universally!

The Hope of Believers

- There's hope that idolaters will come to FEAR the Lord (vs. 11).
- There's hope that people all over the world will WORSHIP the Lord (vs. 11).

Challenge for Believers Today

Believing that God <u>LOVES</u> you—that He cares for you in times of difficulty and that there is hope through the darkness.
